



TURTLE ISLAND WHALE WATCHING



Turtle Island and its surrounding areas have shallow and tranquil waters that are rich in Kuroshio currents, creating a secure habitat for marine life. The marine ecosystem is exceptionally diverse, making it an ideal spot for whale watching enthusiasts. With a chance to observe up to 17 different species of cetaceans, including bottlenose dolphins, spinner dolphins, dwarf sperm whales, and false killer whales, the location offers an exceptional experience. The probability of spotting dolphins is quite high, at approximately 90%, while the likelihood of witnessing whales is around 30%. The best time to visit for whale watching is from April to September.

NATIONAL CENTER FOR TRADITIONAL ARTS

The preparatory work of NCFTA commenced in 1996. In January 2002, the complex reached a completion and the center began to execute its designated missions on cultivating talents in traditional arts and conducting the investigation, research, conservation, transmission and development of traditional arts.
